Conduct Policy

All those involved with junior football at any level, player, parent, spectator, manager, coach, match official has a responsibility to act accordingly to the highest standards of integrity and to ensure that the reputation of the game is, and remains high.

Clubs are responsible for the behaviour of all club members at all their games, home and away. All Clubs are carefully monitored by both the league and the County FA.

We will not tolerate any persons found within the club that display behaviour that is inappropriate and improper.

No Racism Policy

Racial discrimination is illegal and we have a duty at Brighouse Juniors AFC to protect ALL players, managers and officials against this vile form of abuse, whatever their race, colour or religion.

Clubs are responsible for the behaviour of spectators at all their games, home and away.

If any person is found guilty of abuse of any kind then the club will be held responsible.

ALL Clubs are carefully monitored by both the league and the County FA. Any club found guilty of racism may be expelled from the league with immediate effect.

Hygiene and Safety Policy

In the interest of Hygiene and Safety, Brighouse Juniors A.F.C respectfully asks that No Dogs are brought onto the clubs grounds or other pitches used for club games.
